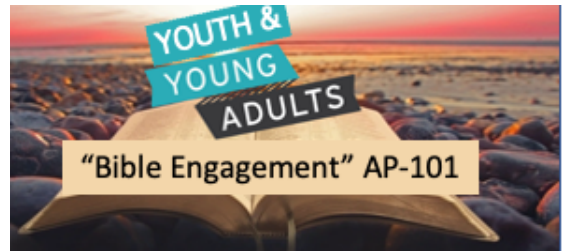

OUR HUMAN CONDITION

ASSIGNMENT

The Scripture readings this week will be Kingdom passages: Kingdom of God / Kingdom of Heaven. You may want to use the word “Realm” or “Commonwealth” as you read these passages to get a more universal sense of what they are talking about.

As you read, consider what they say about your identity, your relationship to God and your relationship to others.

- 12Day 5 Thursday Colossians 1:13-14 (Gift of the Kingdom)
- Day 6 Friday Philippians 3:20 (our citizenship)

Day 7 Rest and Silent Prayer

PRAYER:
